## 2.6.2 - Attainment of Programme outcomes and course outcomes are evaluated by the institution.

Program specific outcomes are measured through both academic and non-academic performances of the students. Total syllabus is taught to the students. Students organize a variety of programs in their departments in the course of the year including exhibitions, fresher's day, cultural day, competitions, farewell function, etc. In addition to this student participate on behalf of their departments in the programs organized by the College. Departments also engage in social outreach activities. On these occasions students display their discernment, social skills, communication skills, creative skills, leadership skills, spirit of team work, readiness to take responsibility, be accountable, etc. The aim here is to make the student socially responsible citizen. The performance of the students in the internal and external examinations, in the practical, assignments and seminar presentation, participation in class activities, role in departmental activities are some of the means by which program specific outcomes are measured. Course outcomes are measured through the performance of the students in the class, practical, internal evaluations, and external evaluations. Students are measured continuously based on their regularity, their receptiveness, participation in class discussions, their answers to questions asked by the teacher and the overall quality of their conduct.
