- The Last Date of examination forms for CAP round admission will be 15 days from the last date of admissions. 9

In case, Admissions governed by Conditional Eligibility the last date for submission of examinations form shall be within fifteen days after declaration of its qualifying examinations provided such students should have been admitted provisionally for its next higher academic session as per Direction No. 27 of 2008 and 6 0f 2010.

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
