The formal event was concluded by the vote of thanks by Chetan Surjuse Department of Chemistry.



Report on Nuclear Disarmament Campaigns

Introduction

Jeevan Vikas Mahavidyalaya, Devgram celebrate Nuclear disarmament campaign. Disarmament is a emerging global issue since the development and use of nuclear weapons during World War II. Over the decades, various international organizations, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and governments have initiated campaigns to advocate for nuclear disarmament, aiming to reduce the number of nuclear weapons worldwide and eventually achieve complete disarmament.

Current Global Situation As of 2024 several countries possess nuclear weapons, including the United States, Russia, China, France, the United Kingdom, India, Pakistan, Israel, and North Korea. Key Campaign Initiatives

- International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons (ICAN): ICAN is a coalition of NGOs that has been at the forefront of global efforts to ban nuclear weapons. It played a significant role in the adoption of the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (TPNW) in 2017, which aims to outlaw nuclear weapons and their use, development, testing, production, acquisition, possession, and deployment.
- 2. Mayors for Peace: Mayors for Peace is an international organization led by mayors from cities around the world. It advocates for the abolition of nuclear weapons and promotes peace initiatives at the local level. The organization's membership includes cities from over 160 countries.
- 3. Global Zero: Global Zero is a movement supported by political leaders, military commanders, and activists worldwide. It seeks the elimination of all nuclear weapons through phased, verified reductions.
- 4. United Nations Efforts: The United Nations has been actively involved in promoting nuclear disarmament through various resolutions, conferences, and initiatives. The TPNW, although not signed by nuclear-armed states, represents a significant step forward in international efforts to delegitimize nuclear weapons.

Challenges and Obstacles

- Resistance from Nuclear-Armed States: Nuclear-armed states
 have expressed concerns about the feasibility and security
 implications of complete disarmament. They argue that nuclear
 weapons serve as a deterrent against aggression and play a
 crucial role in national security strategies.
- Verification and Enforcement: Achieving verifiable disarmament poses significant technical and political challenges. Developing mechanisms for monitoring and verifying disarmament commitments is essential but complex.

3. Public Awareness and Political Will: While public opinion generally favors nuclear disarmament, translating this sentiment into concrete political action remains challenging. Some governments prioritize nuclear deterrence and defense policies over disarmament efforts.

Conclusion

Despite challenges from nuclear-armed states and logistical hurdles, these campaigns continue to play a crucial role in shaping global attitudes towards nuclear weapons.
