REPORT

INTRODUCTION

One-day National Webinar on “*Perspectives of Women's Empowerment in Indian English Literature*” was organized on Tuesday, the 18th April 2023 from 10.00 am to 1.30 pm on Zoom platform by the Departments of English of three colleges (Jeevan Vikas Mahavidyalaya, Devgram, Nagpur; Vasantrao Naik Govt Institute of Arts and Social Sciences, Nagpur and Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur, Nagpur). The registration was done by 138 faculty members and students of different colleges. More than 51 participants were present in this event. The webinar was also made YouTube live so that the participants from all corners of the country should take the advantage.

INAUGURAL SESSION

The Webinar was started sharply at 10.00 am on 18th April 2023 with a formal welcome of the guests. Dr. Jyobi George, Principal, Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur chaired the Session. One of the Organizing Secretaries Dr. Kapil Singhel, Head, Department of English, VNGIASS, Nagpur made an introductory remarks. It was followed by the best wishes of Professor S. CONCEPT NOTE

Literary pieces in Indian Writing in English have raised the quandaries of women in the social structure from various aspects. R. K. Narayana, Bhabhani Bhattacharya, Nayantara Sahgal, Anita Desai, Shashi Deshpande, Namita Gokhale, Shobha De, Manju Kapur, and Arundhati Roy are a few prominent names who have given space to women's plight. Considering the exploitation of the past in all its contours, it is herewith taken up to fight it down under all given circumstances. As such equality being the birthright of any individual, a woman too is entitled to all the liberty to choose her lifestyle, her profession, and her general behavioral pattern.

Indian novelists can be said to be highly conscious of the women's liberation movement. They have portrayed women and their stories with the consciousness of the injustice meted out to women by society. These novels have a feminist undercurrent. If carefully looked at these fictional female characters, a large number of them rebel against the existing social setup. They disregard the idea of being submissive, suffering, and sacrificing. These protagonists in the novels of Indian women novelists often rebel rather than submit and die through suffocation. They conform to the social setup but do not lose their identity and strength of mind. They are confident, enterprising, ambitious, and individualistic New Women who demand attention equality, and peace not on compromising terms but on terms at par with men.

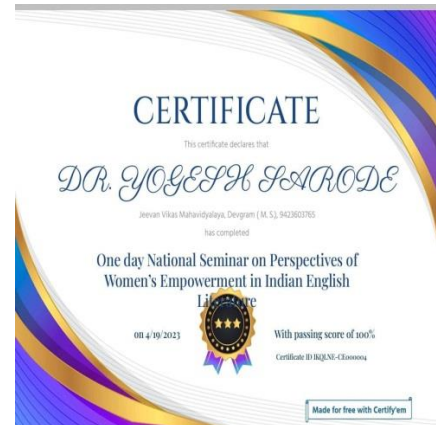
