



Objective: To involve the local population in discussions about sustainable ways to overcome nutritional

challenges.

On March 25, 2022, a field visit addressing the issue of malnutrition was organized in Umatha village by the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Jeevan Vikas Mahavidyalaya, Devgram. This important outreach program aimed to assess the nutritional status of the local tribal population and raise awareness about proper nutrition, health care, and dietary practices. A total of 132 participants, including NSS volunteers, faculty members, and healthcare professionals, took part in the initiative. During the visit, the team conducted health check-ups, including measuring the height and weight of children to monitor growth and detect signs of malnutrition. Information sessions were also held to educate the villagers on balanced diets, the importance of vitamins and minerals, and practical ways to prepare nutritious meals using locally available food resources.

In addition to providing health guidance, the NSS team distributed nutritional supplements and educational materials to the villagers. Efforts were made to inform mothers and caregivers about infant and child feeding practices, hygiene, and the importance of sanitation in preventing diseases. The community engagement during the visit highlighted the challenges faced by tribal populations regarding access to adequate healthcare and nutrition. The program served as a critical step in building awareness and promoting solutions to combat malnutrition in remote areas. The efforts of Jeevan Vikas Mahavidyalaya's NSS unit underscored their ongoing commitment to social welfare, public health, and the upliftment of underprivileged communities.

Impact: Many villagers, especially women, gained valuable knowledge about nutritional health, child care, and hygiene practices. It demonstrated that through education, awareness, and support, significant strides can be made toward improving public health and empowering vulnerable communities.







Introduction

- **Tree Plantation**: In collaboration with the Grampanchayat, Devgram, and Shashikala Foundation, this initiative involved 230 participants in tree plantation, highlighting community commitment to reforestation and environmental preservation.
- **Plastic-Free Village Campaigns**: Conducted in November and with 204 participants, these activities focused on educating locals about the impact of plastic waste and fostering environmentally conscious habits.
- **Eco-Friendly Celebrations** (Rakshabandhan and Holi): Engaging over 184 participants, these events promoted eco-friendly alternatives in cultural celebrations, encouraging sustainable and respectful observance of traditional festivities.

• **Awareness on Renewable Energy**: Aimed at enlightening the community on sustainable energy sources, this initiative had 143 participants and emphasized the long-term benefits of renewable energy use.

3. Health and Wellness Programs

- **Blood Donation and Health Camps**: Conducted with support from the Primary Health Center (PHC), Jalalkheda, these camps offered medical services to 394 participants. The blood donation drive and various health check-ups were instrumental in providing crucial health services to the rural population.
- **Fitness and Wellness Events** (Fit India Movement): Engaging 230 participants, this event encouraged physical activity and wellness, aligning with the national Fit India campaign's objectives.
- **AIDS/Environmental Awareness Programs**: With 274 attendees, these programs highlighted important health topics, raising awareness about AIDS, environmental sustainability, and other critical health issues.

4. Skill Development and Economic Awareness Programs

- Work on Digital Literacy and Cashless India: With a combined attendance of 278, these programs focused on empowering community members with digital skills, essential for thriving in an increasingly digital economy.
- One-Day Workshop on Career Opportunities in Fashion Designing: This workshop attracted 104 participants, equipping students with skills relevant to the fashion industry, offering them insights into career paths in this sector.
- **Pradhan Mantri Yojanas** (Jan Dhan, Jeevan Bima): Focused on financial literacy and insurance awareness, these programs saw nearly 362 participants, aiming to familiarize citizens with financial security and banking facilities, supporting national financial inclusion initiatives.

5. Cultural and Heritage Activities

- Ganeshotsav and Navratri Mahotsav: These events, with a high engagement of around 473 participants, included cultural programs, fostering a sense of community, cultural appreciation, and participation among students and local citizens.
- **Meri Mati Mera Desh**: This program, which included 149 participants, encouraged the celebration of the nation's heritage, strengthening cultural bonds and a sense of pride among participants.
- Patang Mahotsav and Eco-Friendly Festivals: Through events like Patang Mahotsav, Antyoday Mahavidyalaya celebrated cultural heritage in an eco-friendly manner, involving 168 participants in a traditional and environmentally respectful way.

6. Civic Engagement and Community Cleanliness

• Swachh Bharat Abhiyan and Gram Swachhta Abhiyan: These cleanliness drives saw impressive participation from 294 individuals, promoting hygiene and environmental

- responsibility. The activities helped instill a sense of ownership and responsibility toward maintaining a clean environment.
- Samuh Rashtra Gaan and Cleanliness Bike Rally: With a cumulative attendance of 787, these events promoted national pride and public responsibility, encouraging the community to work together for a cleaner and more unified society.

Overview

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit at Antyoday Mahavidyalaya, Devgram, in collaboration with various community organizations, government offices, and NGOs, implemented a diverse set of extension and outreach programs during the 2022-2023 academic year. These initiatives aimed to promote social awareness, environmental consciousness, and health improvement within the community. - O Youth Information Ambassador Workshop: Conducted in partnership with the Collector Office, Nagpur, this workshop engaged 98 participants, equipping students with knowledge on leadership and public service.

Analysis

This initiative helped mitigate the spread of COVID-19 within the community, emphasizing preventive practices.
- Vaccination Awareness Week and Vaccination Camp: Recognizing the importance of vaccination, the college conducted awareness campaigns and set up vaccination camps. These programs reached 170 individuals, fostering a provaccination mindset and providing access to vaccines.

2. Legal Aid and Social Support

o The **Vidhi Seva** (**Legal Aid**) initiative, conducted in collaboration with legal professionals from Nagpur, provided essential legal guidance to 120 community members. This program broadened access to legal support and educated participants on their rights and resources during the pandemic, contributing to community resilience in times of crisis.

3. Environmental Conservation

o **Tree Plantation** and **Mission Oxygen** were conducted to address environmental concerns while aligning with the institution's commitment to sustainability.
