## I. Pattern of Question Paper

---

### A) Pattern of Question Paper for Papers with 4 Credits

1. Each paper will have four Units.
2. The question paper will consist of five questions and all questions shall be compulsory.
3. The first four long answer questions (each to be answered in approximately 1000 words) will be based on the four units. Each unit will have an internal choice (one question to be attempted out of two). These questions will be based on the text prescribed for detailed study.
4. The fifth short answer question (to be answered in approximately 200 words) will be based on the topics prescribed for background study. This question will be compulsory; questions from all four units will carry equal weightage and there will be no internal choice.

### B) Pattern of Question Paper for Papers with 2 Credits

1. Each paper will have two Units.
2. The question paper will consist of three questions and all questions shall be compulsory.
3. The first two long answer questions (each to be answered in approximately 1000 words) will be based on the two units. Each unit will have an internal choice (one question to be attempted out of two).
4. The third short answer question (to be answered in approximately 200 words) will be based on background topics. This question will be compulsory; questions from both units will carry equal weightage and there will be no internal choice.

## IV. General Guidelines

---

### 1. On Job Training (OJT / Internship)

- Students must complete 3 to 4 weeks (total 120 Hours) of On Job Training (Internship/Apprenticeship) during Semester-I.

- Completion of 4-credit OJT/Internship during the after 1st semester before the Second Semester of the First Year is mandatory.
- Students must prepare a comprehensive day-to-day internship report and submit it to the Head of the Department before the commencement of the theory examination of the concerned semester.
- This report will carry 80 marks and the internal assessment will carry 20 marks.

## 2. Field Project

- Students shall conduct a field project on a topic deemed relevant to society by the Head of the Department.
- Students must conduct a survey, collect data, and carry out its analysis and interpretation.
- The project must present convincing conclusions and recommendations.
- The report must be submitted to the Head of the Department before the commencement of the theory examination of the concerned semester.
- This report will carry 80 marks and the internal assessment will carry 20 marks.

## 3. Research Project – Semester III and IV

- Semester-III carries 4 credits and Semester-IV carries 6 credits for the Research Project.
- The project must be carried out under the supervision of a faculty member and approved by the Head of the Department.
- Students may undertake separate projects for Semester-III and IV, or may continue the Semester-III project into Semester-IV.

## 4. Semester-III Research Project – Marks Distribution

Component	Marks
Project Report	80
Internal Assessment	20
<b>Total</b>	<b>100 (4 Credits)</b>

A minimum of 50 marks combined (project + internal assessment) is required to pass.

## 5. Semester-IV Research Project – Marks Distribution

Component	Marks
Project Report	120
Internal Assessment	30
<b>Total</b>	<b>150 (6 Credits)</b>

A minimum of 75 marks combined is required to pass. Submission of the report before the commencement of the theory examination of the concerned semester is mandatory.

## 6. Conditions for Continuing Semester-III Project into Semester-IV

Students who wish to continue their Semester-III project into Semester-IV must fulfil the following conditions:

### **In Semester-III, students shall prepare a Research Proposal covering the following:**

- a) Selection of research topic / problem
- b) Introduction
- c) Aims, objectives, and scope of research
- d) Hypotheses
- e) Research Methodology
- f) Literature Review
- g) Data Collection
- h) Data Analysis & Interpretation / finding of the study
- i) Suggestions
- j) Conclusion
- k) References
- l) Appendix

### **In Semester-IV, students shall complete the following:**

- a) Understanding Academic Writing
- b) Interpretation and analysis of primary and secondary data
- c) Writing the Research Project Report
